To apply for a fingerprint clearance card:

- 1. Go to https://www.azdps.gov/services/public/fingerprint
- 2. Click "Fingerprint Clearance Card Applications, Requests, and Status Checks"
- 3. Select "Fingerprint Clearance Card"
- 4. Complete the application process by following the instructions on the website. You may need to create an account
 - a. All child care employees and volunteers need a **non-IVP** Fingerprint Clearance Card
 - b. All teachers in Arizona need an IVP Fingerprint Clearance Card
 - i. The same background check is done for both. If you plan to ever become a teacher in kindergarten and up, apply for the IVP card by selecting "teacher through the Department of Education". If you plan to stay in preschool, apply for the non-IVP card.
- 5. Take your application to a center that scans fingerprints, they will scan your prints and submit your application and fingerprints directly to DPS. The application website should provide a list of locations that will scan and submit your application.
